If you wish to pay by credit card, call the Lodge Secretary at (703) 560-2188 (ext. 2), and give her the credit card information. This will allow you to use your credit card without paying the extra that is stated on the dues notice.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE</u>: Any member who does <u>NOT</u> renew their membership will no longer be permitted entrance to the Lodge or its Social Quarters (even as a guest); however, they will be allowed to reinstate membership at the Lodge.

<u>LIFE MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION</u>: If you are over the age of 65 and have been a member in good standing for 30 years, you still have to pay dues, but they are greatly reduced. The Lodge still must pay the Grand Lodge assessment (which will increase in 2023 to \$29) and the State assessment of \$5. The assessments totaling \$34 that are listed on the dues statement you will receive are not optional. The Lodge has to pay them for every member who is listed on our roster on April 1.



**ATTENTION MEMBERS:** If you are <u>not</u> receiving e-blasts from the Lodge, please notify Lodge Secretary Jan Sullivan. There have been instances of people being unsubscribed – either inadvertently or intentionally. Work on the **2023 Golf Schedule** is in the final stage. By the time you read this it should be completed. If you belonged to the Golf Association in 2022 or joined recently and are on my email list, you will receive a copy automatically. If you are not and want a copy, contact me (Ron Murphy) at (703) 866-4403 or bettyron.50@gmail.com.

I can tell you that we plan to open in mid-April, finish up in late October, and play about fifteen events in between. We will play many, but not all, of the courses as last season. These will include Old Hickory, Hidden Creek, Prince William, Forest Greens, South Riding,

Bull Run, Pleasant Valley, Heritage Hunt, Penderbrook, Raspberry Falls, Herndon, and may include one or more new places. All play will be on Mondays and, except for the final at South Riding, will have a 9:00A start, and South Riding will be at 10:00A.

We prefer shotgun starts. However, many courses will not agree to a shotgun unless we have at least 40 players. Last season we fell short of this count in several, if not most, of our events. We are not sure why. COVID is a likely suspect since so many changes have occurred since that experience. But COVID is over now, and we are encouraging all Elks Lodge #2188 golfers to return and play. In an effort to boost membership, we are reducing the membership fee to \$35 this season. That is a 20% plus reduction. Prices of everything else are going up. We take pride in being anti-inflationary.

Our sign-up procedures remain the same. Players will need to sign up for the Monday event by the preceding Thursday. A reminder email will be sent a week prior to members with appropriate instructions. All Lodge members are invited to join the Golf Association. Lodge members who choose to not join may play individual events as guests.

Sunrise and sunset will be about 1 hour later on March 12, 2023 than the day before. There will be more light in the evening. Also called Spring Forward, Summer Time, and Daylight Savings Time. Two states don't do daylight saving time: Hawaii and Arizona.
